

# Talks On FridayS (TOFS) Student Development and Recognition Program

Talks On FridayS (TOFS), also known as Try it On For Size, is a weekly, student-run seminar series hosted by Lawson Health Research Institute (Lawson).

## **Objectives**

TOFS is designed to provide students with opportunities to develop professional skills in a structured program recognized by the institution. The primary objectives are:

- To gain experience in presenting conference-style oral presentations to an audience
- To prepare for internal competitions, such as London Health Research Day
- To provide formal recognition for students and trainees committed to professional development
