- The stroke program is an internationally recognized interdisciplinary group of neurologists, neuroradiologists and neurosurgeons with strong interests in education, research, and stroke policy and advocacy.
- London Health Sciences Center is the regional academic Stroke Center for the Southwestern Ontario Region.
 - Comprehensive Stroke Unit: 31-bed stroke unit, including 6 beds in Hyperacute Stroke (level 2 unit)
- Urgent TIA/ Stroke Prevention
 - ▶ 5 days per week, seeing 2000 referrals/year
 - Support from 1 NP, 2 RN
- Endovascular thrombectomy service
 - > 201 mechanical thrombectomies in 2022/2023 fiscal year.
 - One of the highest referral rates for EVT in the province of Ontario

- Based on the Canadian Stroke Consortium National Stroke Fellowship Certification Program
- We offer three levels of stroke certification for fellows, tailored to their objectives:
- Stroke Certificate: 6 m
- Stroke Expert: 12 m

Western Stroke Fellowship Program Service Rotations

- Outpatients: Mix of Urgent TIA Clinic/ Consultant's General Stroke Prevention Clinic
 - ▶ 4 half-days per week
- Inpatient Stroke Clinical Teaching Unit
 - 2 weeks at a time, total of 4-6 months/year
- ► On-Call:
 - Max 4 calls per month, Weekend: 12hrs (max 2), + Weekday back-up to off-service/ junior resident (5 pm to 8 AM)
- Electives: research, rehab medicine & physiatry, neuro-critical care, neuro-interventional, and others
