Medical Expert	Apply medical knowledge, clinical skills and professional attitudes in the their provision of patient centered care. Medical Expert is the central physician role in the CanMEDS Framework.	Medical knowledge
Communicator	Physicians effectively facilitate the doctor- patient relationship and the dynamic exchanges that occur before, during, and after the medical encounter.	Interpersonal skills and communication
Collaborator	Physicians effectively work within a healthcare team to achieve optimal patient care.	Interpersonal skills and communication & Patient Care
Manager	Physicians are integral participants in healthcare organization, organizing sustainable practices, making decisions about allocating resources, and contributing to the effectiveness of the healthcare system.	Systems-based practice
Health Advocate	Physicians responsibly use their expertise and influence to advance the health and wellbeing of individual patients, communities, and populations.	No ACGME equivalent
Scholar	Physicians demonstrate a lifelong commitment to reflective learning, as well as the creation, dissemination, application and translation of medical knowledge.	Practice-based learning and improvement
Professionalism	Physicians are committed to the health and well-being of individuals and society through ethical practice, profession-led regulation and high personal standards of behavior.	Professionalism
