Getting dialysis wrong:

Newly appreciated badness and novel ways to make it better

Objectives:

- 1. Appreciate that poor outcomes for dialysis patients is derived partly from the treatment itself
- 2. Circulatory stress of the treatment causes multiple ischemic organ injuries
- 3. Salt is a major uremic toxin and builds up in tissues causing further injury
- 4. All of the above are amenable to novel interventions cast in an evolved understanding of the nature of the injury

Dr McIntyre moved from the UK in 2014 and is now Professor of Medicine, Pediatrics and Medical Biophysics. He is the inaugural holder of the Robert Lindsay Chair of Dialysis Research and Innovation at the University of Western Ontario.
