Cancer Genetics for the Internist: Clinical Updates & Lessons Learned

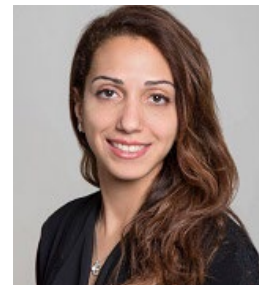
Objectives:
