- B. N95 Fit Testing – Back Hallway (1:30-3:30pm)** (Must have pre-registered on the sign-up sheet located outside of Aud. A. First come first served as they can only accommodate 6 people per 30 min)
- C. Parking** - Located at University Hospital – North West Parking Garage, 1st floor (beside the main hospital). Parking rates will vary for city wide versus hospital specific parking. Government issued photo identification is necessary.
