FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM





Anesthesia fellowships in acute pain, cardiac, liver transplant, neuroscience, obstetric, perioperative echocardiography & ultrasound, quality improvement, regional, simulation, and vascular & thoracic are offered each year at the London Health Sciences Centre and St. Joseph's Health Care London.

Fellowships are 12 months in duration.

Programs are individualized to meet the goals of successful applicants. Generally, clinical experience is the focus along with improvement in clinical research. Fellows spend approximately four days per week in clinical activities with one day per week protected for non-clinical activities, and participe in night call schedule (from home).

Fellows are also encouraged to be actively involved in resident, medical student and nursing education, didactic lectures and to participate in anesthesia rounds and specialty conferences.

Applications are usually considered 12 - 18 months prior to the start date.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for Application:

- Candidates must possess a medical degree from a recognized University.
- Candidates must have completed an anesthesia residency program that is recognized by the CPSO.
- International Medical Graduates must be approved by the Postgraduate Education Office at Western University.
- English Language Requirement: ILTS / TOEFL-iBT required to achieve an overall score of no less than 100 with a minimum score of 24 in speaking or listening (IMG only).
