

























# Fall Term Winter Term Exchange: Western U: Optional/Elective Modular courses required for courses taken while Away progression to year 4 Year 5

#### Keep in Mind:

Requirements to progress to year 4: This scenario works
with modules/module combinations that require half year
courses. We recommend you look at the feasibility of
taking all of your required courses during your terms at
Western and only taking options while away. Otherwise,
you may be able to find exact equivalents for your required
courses at your host institution.
