## SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Direct management of active research being conducted by the supervisor.
- 2. Provide arrhythmia service consultations, attend clinics and participate in procedures (EP and devices if interested).
- 3. Apply for grants for self-funding and for identified studies.
- 4. Write protocols and ethics submissions for studies.
- 5. Approach patients identified for consideration in studies.
- 6. Conduct research protocols on subjects enrolled in the studies.
- 7. Learn and apply statistical methods. Analyze data in advanced statistical software.
- 8. Write high-quality manuscripts for publication in peer-reviewed indexed journals.
