



**Strategic Training Program in Cancer Research & Technology Transfer
(CaRTT) SUMMER STUDENTSHIPS (revised March 7, 2018)**

CaRTT is committed to providing an integrated training program in cancer research leading to better diagnosis or treatment of human disease. In developing partnerships between basic scientists and clinical researchers, it provides stipends for MSc and PhD trainees and postdoctoral fellows.

In a separate program, and in order to bridge the gap to the CaRTT graduate program, CaRTT is offering to help support undergraduate summer students in 2018. Students must: be enrolled in Western University; be under the director supervision of a CaRTT Mentor; and be working on a research project in oncology.

All CaRTT mentors are eligible to apply on behalf of a student they are directly supervising. CaRTT will provide 50% of the stipend (up to a maximum of \$3,000 per student per summer) for a period of up to four (4) months. Western undergraduate students who have completed a minimum of one (1) year of undergraduate training (or are expected to complete it by the time of their summer training experience) are eligible.

1. A one page description of the project the CaRTT/PEL summer student will undertake. (see page 2 for style guidelines and format)
2. An abbreviated *curriculum vitae* of the Mentor, with evidence of sufficient operating funds to support the Trainee's research project, a list of students trained or in training under the Mentor's supervision (last 5 years), and a list of publications (last 5 years).
3. A student transcript (up-to-date as of March 1, 2018).

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION IS MARCH 9, 2018. Notification of awards will be made by end of March 2018. Please note that studentship awards will be limited to one per Mentor per year.

CaRTT is committed to providing funding for up to 10 high school summer students.
