On a mobile device:

1. Tap Home at the bottom of the screen.
2. Swipe right to open the main menu.
3. Tap **Channels** to open the **channel** browser.
4. Search for a **channel** or select one from the list.

For any live Slack events, you can text messages and see what others are texting and reply to the various threads.

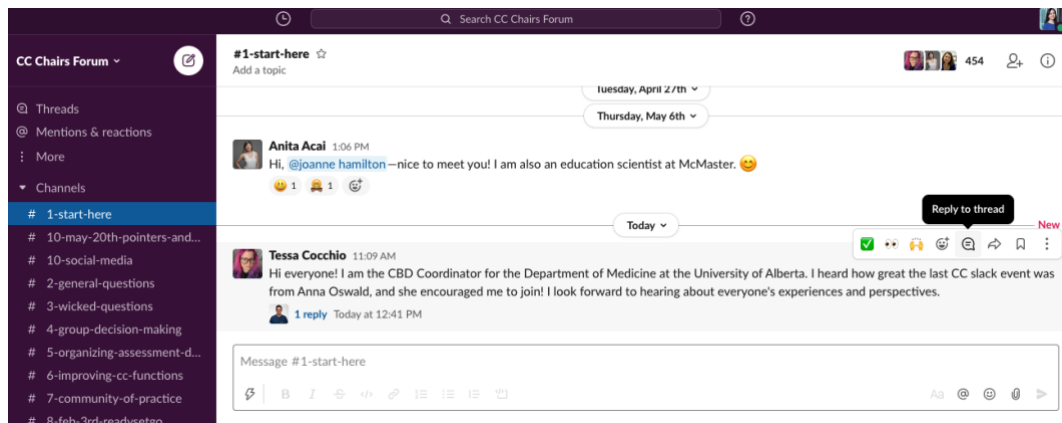
