#### Centre for Translational Cancer Research (CTCR) Travel Awards

The Centre for Translational Cancer Research (CTCR) is pleased to offer competitive Travel Awards for graduate students, residents, and clinical and postdoctoral fellows working in the area of translational cancer research. These awards are intended to enhance the education and training of trainees engaged in translational cancer research. A total of **5 prizes** with a **value of \$1000.00 each** will be available.

#### **Application**

Applicants will be asked to submit a 1-2 minute video (maximum) as well as their written abstract (350 words max.) describing their translational cancer research.

#### **Eligibility**

- The applicant (graduate student, resident, or clinical/postdoctoral fellow) must be presenting their own work as the first-author for a poster or oral presentation at a provincial, national or international academic conference with clear relevance to cancer.
- All applicants must be working under the direct supervision of a CTCR member (For a list of CTCR Members, <u>please click here</u>) with a faculty and/or professional appointment at Western and/or LHSC/SJHC.
- Graduate students, residents, and clinical fellows must be registered, full-time, in a Western Graduate or PGME Program at the time of application and at the time of attending the conference.
- Postdoctoral fellows must be within 5 years of the date on which they received their
   PhD degree at the time of application and at the time of attending the conference.
- Applicants who hold scholarships that include designated supplement for travel are not eligible to apply.
- A maximum of one travel award per graduate student, resident, or clinical/postdoctoral fellow will be awarded within a given year.

### **Deadline**

The CTCR Travel Award application deadline is Friday, October 26, 2018, at 4:00pm, for conferences taking place from **July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.

# **Selection Process**

 Received applications will be reviewed by the Travel Awards Selection Committee, comprised of members of the CTCR Management Committee.

- Successful applicants will be notified via email within one month of the application deadline. All successful applicants will be announced through various social media outlets, strategic communication newsletters and all videos will be shared on the CTCR website.
- Evidence of abstract acceptance is required before travel awards will be released to successful applicants.
- Successful applicants will be expected to provide a short report to the CTCR
  Management Committee regarding how the award had an impact upon their training.
  The report may be in the form of a lecture, video, report or blog pertaining to their field of study.
- The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.

#### **Conditions and Logistics**

- Video presentations are limited to 1-2 minutes maximum. Videos exceeding 2 minutes will be disqualified.
- Videos should be creative, convey enthusiasm about the research being conducted and capture the audience's attention (Mix of clinicians, scientists, trainees and administration).
- Presentations must include sufficient background, the aim of the research, as well as its significance and impact (Follow a similar structure to the abstract).
- PowerPoint, YouTube, Prezi software must be used for creating your video. Applicants may submit a request to use a different software program to Kimberly Trudgeon (<u>kimberly.trudgeon@lhsc.on.ca</u>) by October 1, 2018.
- Please ensure your video link works properly before submitting your application.
- o Clarity, legibility, content and appropriateness will also be graded.
- The primary selection criteria will be the scientific/academic merit of the applicant's abstract in the context of translational cancer research.
- The career stage of the applicant will be taken into consideration and given appropriate weighting during the review process.
