#### 1. Welcome & Additions to Minutes

#### 3. Current Business

#### 3.1 Welcome New Management Committee Members

Welcome new Management Committee Members, Drs. Sarah Mattonen, Armen Parsyan and Silvia Penuela. Each gave a brief description of their backgrounds and research.

## 3.2 City Wide Director Search

No news to report. Recruitment has been slowed due to the search for a new Chair, Department of Oncology and Covid. Dr. Bauman has been involved in meetings and explaining how the role of City-Wide Director would differ from the role of Chair, Department of Oncology and the need to join London's pool of cancer researchers/clinicians. The history of the formation and the role of the CTCR was reviewed. By joining all London cancer researchers and clinicians, the CTCR has the opportunity to be a virtual academic centre. It can act as a 'clearinghouse' to help form relationships and bridge partnership between members. The CTCR is already seen by institutions outside the London area such as the OICR as London's academic cancer centre.

#### 3.3 Maud L. Menten Lecture

As part of the CTCR's mandate, we try to partner with other groups to promote cancer research. We had partnered with the Maud L. Menten organizing group to co-host the lecture on April 17, 2020. Unfortunately, the event was cancelled due to Covid.

## 3.4 Website Update

Schulich Western's Communication Department has had to again delay the update of CTCR's website to the new format till the new year due to Covid. The content within the website has been updated.

#### 3.5 Cure4Glioma

Dr. John Ronald reported that a meeting had been set up in September to reform the group but due to the busyness surrounding the start of the academic year, it has been delayed to November. Dr. Ronald mentioned that several group members have been successful in obtaining individual grants but have not yet secured large funding to establish an official group. He also mentioned that a new London area leader will be sought. Windsor's leader remains Dr. Lisa Porter.

#### 3.6 OICR Update

Dr. Bauman is a part time clinical lead and advisor to the OICR. The committee has been working on a new strategic plan and he shared part of the new plan to the attendees.

#### 3.7 Dr. D. Hanahan Talk

The CTCR has secured Dr. Douglas Hanahan, the co-author of "The Hallmarks of Cancer" to speak virtually at a CTCR sponsored event on Thursday, November 12. The first half of his 2.5hours talk will focus on his lab's research and the second half will focus on the creation of a research community in Zurich.

## 3.8 Immuno-Oncology Symposium

The first event on February 6, 2019 was so successful that the committee has reformed and will host the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Immuno-Oncology Symposium on Tuesday, February 9, 2021. More details to follow when available.

#### 3.9 Catalyst Grant Survey

The CTCR does not directly fund the Catalyst Grants but its members directly benefit from the monetary awards. A survey measuring the impact of the funds on its members will be sent out to the 2015-2019 awardees in early November.
