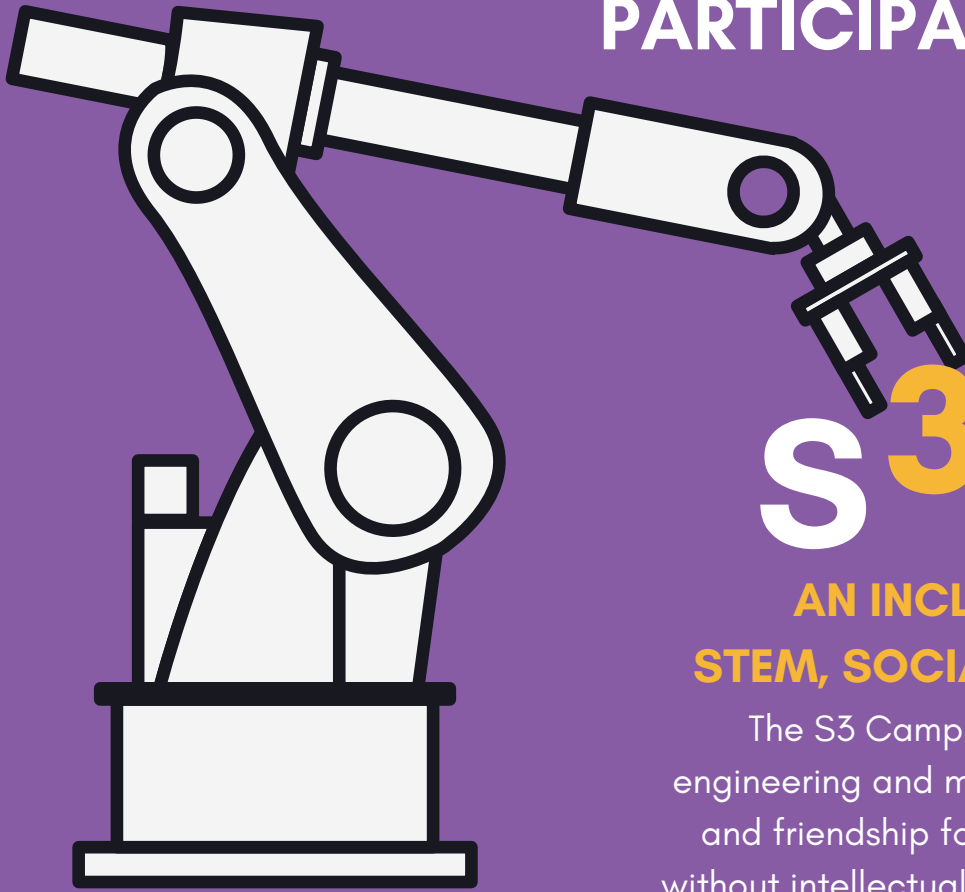

S³ CAMP

**AN INCLUSIVE CAMP PROMOTING
STEM, SOCIAL SKILLS AND FRIENDSHIP**

The S3 Camp study examines science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) skills, social skills, and friendship formation in youth ages 10-13 with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities in an inclusive informal learning environment.

JULY 10 - 14 OR JULY 17-22 | 9 AM TO 4 PM DAILY

Participants must be 10 to 13 years of age and have an interest in attending all 5 days of camp. Participants with an intellectual or developmental disability must have a diagnosis from a registered health practitioner.

PARTICIPANTS WILL:

- Attend the S3 camp for 5 days
- Collaboratively work on STEM activities including coding and robotics
- Participate in lessons on communicating and interacting with others
- Receive disability awareness lessons
- Parents will participate in a 1-hour pre-assessment and a 45-minute to 1.5 hour post-assessment. At the same time, youth will complete a 25-minute pre-assessment and 35-minute to 1-hour and 20-minute post-assessment.*
