## Orthodontics for Dental Hygienists

### PROGRAM OUTLINE

This course is designed exclusively for registered dental hygienists in Ontario who wish to expand their knowledge and clinical skills in orthodontics. It provides a formal advanced education in orthodontic procedures, allowing participants to develop the expertise necessary to support orthodontic treatment within their scope of practice, as regulated by the College of Dental Hygienists of Ontario (CDHO).

The course includes comprehensive lectures covering orthodontic principles and hands-on clinical training using dentofoms and dental mannequins at the Schulich School of Dentistry Simulation Clinic. Instruction is provided by expert orthodontic faculty and experienced orthodontic professionals, ensuring close supervision and individualized guidance through capped enrollment.

Participants will receive a detailed course manual and study guide. To ensure competency, both the didactic and clinical components will be evaluated, and successful participants will receive a signed certificate of completion at the end of the course.

- Handpiece Workshop for Orthodontic Clean-Up
