

## Financial Aid Information Bursaries & Schulich Scholarships

### ADMISSION BURSARIES

Student Financial Services is responsible for the Financial Aid Programs at Western University. We encourage all incoming Dentistry students to apply for an Admission Bursary.

Admission Bursaries are non-repayable grants awarded on the basis of financial need. In this process, financial need is determined in a manner similar to the Canada and Ontario Government Student Loans assessment. Costs of the Dentistry program are compared against the resources you have available.

The amount of the bursary you are eligible for will be applied directly to your tuition account.

To be considered, you must submit an online **Admission Bursary Application** which is available on the following webpage:

**NOTE:** *DDS Program for Internationally Trained Dentists, or Advanced Standing Program students, are eligible for Fall/Winter bursary only. Use the Financial Assistance Application which becomes available by the end of August.*

The Admission Bursary Application will close on July 10, 2024. If you miss this deadline, you will have an opportunity to apply and be considered for bursary funding once the online Financial Assistance Application becomes available again by the end of August.

### SCHULICH SCHOLARSHIPS

Four Schulich Scholarships are awarded annually to students entering the first year of the Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) Program, based on academic achievement and demonstrated financial need. These scholarships are reserved for students who meet Ontario residency requirements.

Schulich Scholarships continue for up to four years, provided recipients progress satisfactorily and demonstrate financial need each year. The scholarships were established to help ensure that qualified students have access to a dental education, should they so desire. The School is committed to assisting students to achieve this vision.

The value of the Schulich Dentistry Scholarships is \$13,500 per year, continuing for the duration of your dental education (for a total of \$54,000).

To apply for a Schulich Scholarship, you must submit an on-line Admission Bursary or Financial Assistance application, *and* a supplemental application specific to the Schulich Scholarship.

The supplemental application for the Schulich Scholarships will be available in early-August from the Office of the Registrar's website, under heading *Dentistry Scholarships*. The application deadline will also be posted on this webpage:
