Eligibility	Any resident PGY1 or PGY2 or PGY3 training in Windsor. Call for nominations will begin Friday, November 27, 2015.
Award Value	The 2016 award recipient will receive a framed certificate and \$500.
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominations must be made by individuals (team/group nominations will not be accepted) • The nomination form must be submitted electronically • Nominations may be submitted by preceptors, staff and residents <p>Nominations should focus on the individual's primary area(s) of strength. It is advantageous to nominees to concentrate on those specific categories where the individual has an outstanding record.</p>
Nomination Procedure	<p>To nominate a resident:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete the cover page nomination form. 2. Submit an electronic copy of the nomination form (one PDF file) which includes the nomination form and completed 'Description of Nominee' to Nicole Sbrocca nsbrocca@uwindsor.ca by Friday, February 12, 2016.
Selection Process	Those nominated will be adjudicated by a Selection Committee comprised of the Academic Director for PGME in the Department of Family Medicine, the Academic Director of UME in the Department of Family Medicine, the Assistant Academic Coordinator for Family Medicine Windsor, members of the Windsor Family Medicine PGME Committee or others at the discretion of the Program Director for the Windsor Program Family Medicine Residency.
Presentation of Awards	Recipients will be notified of their award in the spring of 2016. Recipients will be presented with their awards at the Windsor Program's <i>Celebration of Excellence Dinner</i> on Tuesday, April 12, 2016.
