Dr. Allan Donner

Internationally renowned scholar Dr. Allan Donner holds the honors of being a Fellow of the American Statistical Association, the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences, and the Royal Society of Canada. He is Professor Emeritus in the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry and Biostatistical Scientist at Robarts Clinical Trials, Western University.

Dr. Donner's methodological research includes extensive contributions to the design and analysis of clinical trials, including frequent invited presentations, publications in leading journals, and service on numerous Data Safety and Monitoring Committees. His interest in cluster randomization trials has led to his participation in several perinatal epidemiology trials sponsored by the World Health Organization and trials of vaccination strategies designed to prevent typhoid and cholera in developing countries.

Dr. Donner was Chair of the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics from 1987 through 2003.
