

Dr. Pederson is an Epidemiologist who currently holds adjunct professorships in the Department of Family Medicine and the Faculty of Nursing at Western University. She received her PhD from the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics, Western University, where she was a professor until 1995. Subsequently, she was a Senior Scientist in the Office on Smoking and Health at the Centre for Disease Control and Prevention, Atlanta, Georgia. Her research focused on tobacco use and tobacco control, as well as on health communication promoting prevention and cessation. She has published over 200 articles and book chapters, on a range of topics, including original research, reviews of the literature and reports on combining qualitative and quantitative methods. She currently is an adjunct professor at the Morehouse School of Medicine.
