



Name of Rotation:	Community Pediatrics - Chatham
Description of Rotation:	In Chatham we offer the clinical clerk or resident time to work on pediatric cases in the office, in the ER, on the inpt unit and with healthy newborns after birth. We also offer time in our Level 2 nursery working with prems and high needs infants.
Rotation Contact:	Dr. Wendy Edwards
Description of Clinical Duties Performed:	"Duties" include doing consultant histories and physical exams on new pts, doing follow up appts with others. Students are often asked to see cases we are consulted in the ER or the inpt floor FIRST, and report to us. Students should be prepared to dictate notes, review labs and tests, and discuss differential dx and plans.
Sample Schedule:	Students will usually work with the pediatrician on call, so they have opportunity to see most acute cases. They are NOT expected to stay "on call" each night.
On-Call Requirements:	None. We do ask however that they be willing to come in for "exciting" cases if contacted by the pediatrician on call after hours.
Description of Setting:	Office, where all 6 peds work together. Hospital, including ER if called down to case, peds inpt floor (doing daily rounds), and newborn unit/as well as level 2 nursery (doing daily rounds)
Clinical Supervision:	Will be done by peds on call with you based on your level of comfort and your abilities You will likely work with all 6 pediatricians at least once

Clinical Content:	Luck of the draw as per inpt and ER pts. Could include new diabetic, seizures, asthma, bronchiolitis, dehydration cases, etc. In office will see ADHD, school and behaviour issues, depression/anxiety in various age groups, constipation, rashes, etc.
Objectives/Expectations:	To come away having seen many cases from newborn to teen, feeling comfortable working with all ages and with whole family.  To understand how to deal with basic peds and newborn urgent needs.
Level of Residents Accepted:	PGY1,PGY2
Teaching:	Sometimes we have a med student with us and really appreciate when the resident helps in teaching them.  We are always keen for residents to present to our group or even hospital grand rounds if time permits
