On-Call Requirements:	Home call. Calls: twice a week 5-11 PM. Paeds ward, newborns, ER consults.
Description of Setting:	1 -Group office setting for consultation paediatrics 2- Hospital: ward and ER
Clinical Supervision:	There will be always clinical supervision. The degree will depend on the resident level. We have the opportunity to do observation through a one way mirror.
