<b>Description of Rotation:</b>	<p>Combination of hospital and office-based paediatrics. In the hospital we do normal newborn care, premature newborns - NICU level 2.</p> <p>In the office we have a good variety of paediatric experiences: medical, behavioural, developmental</p> <p>We offer: exposure to paediatrics advocacy roles, school meetings, critical roles of allied health providers.</p> <p>Consults from our Emergency department , including community consultations calls. Calls for high risk deliveries.</p>

<b>Description of Clinical Duties:</b>	<p>Hospital: AM- rounding on newborns / SCN/ paediatric ward/ ER</p> <p>Office: afternoon 1-5 Pm. Sometimes outreach clinic 9 to 5.</p>
<b>On-Call Requirements:</b>	<p>Home call.</p> <p>Calls: twice a week 5-11 PM. Paeds ward, newborns, ER consults.</p>
<b>Description of Setting:</b>	<p>1 -Group office setting for consultation paediatrics</p> <p>2- Hospital: ward and ER</p>
<b>Clinical Supervision:</b>	<p>There will be always clinical supervision. The degree will depend on the resident level.</p> <p>We have the opportunity to do observation through a one way mirror.</p>
