

Name of Rotation:	Emergency Medicine - Goderich
Description of Rotation:	This is a rural Emergency Medicine rotation, focusing on skills in the emergency department setting. There is opportunity for a wide variety of exposure to rural emergency medicine cases.
Rotation Contact:	Dr. Tamra Steinmann
Description of Clinical Duties:	Clinical duties include emergency department shifts, with potential opportunities for airway practice with anesthesia, if interest.
Sample Schedule:	15 shifts in a 4-week block. Shifts are 8 hours in length (8am-4pm, 4pm-12am and 12am-8am)
On-Call Requirements:	There is no on-call requirements
Description of Setting:	The Alexandra Marine and General Hospital in Goderich has a 24/hour ER department with access to labs, imaging, CT scanner, general surgery, anesthesia, ER back-up, obstetrics. Opportunities to work in collaboration with Nurse Practitioner in ER as well
Supervision:	Direct supervision by family physician.
Clinical Content:	An average volume of 20-30 cases present to the ER in an 8 hour day shift. Volumes in the summer are usually higher.
Objectives/Expectations:	Goal of this rotation is to instill confidence and clinical knowledge, to ensure residents are comfortable identifying and managing common ER presentations in a rural setting with limited resources. Additional Expectation: Presentation at Grand Rounds on an ER topic of choice.
Level of Residents Accepted:	All levels of training accepted.
Teaching:	Occasional opportunities to teach Western medical students. Monthly grand round teaching sessions.
