

Name of Rotation:	Hospitalist – Physical Medicine/Rehabilitation (Parkwood)
Description of Rotation:	Inpatient hospitalist rotation at Parkwood with opportunities for outpatient physiatry clinic experience, if desired. Supervisor: Family Medicine Hospitalist.

Description of Clinical Duties:	Responsibility: One inpatient unit (~10-15 patients) - either Stroke, MSK, Brain injury, Spinal cord rehab options. Round with physiatrist, typically 1-2x/week; outpatient physiatry opportunities to enhance learning needs. Team rounds weekly: to enhance learning of each discipline: OT, PT, SLP, Psychology, SW, Nursing.
Sample Schedule:	Each day/week is the same 9am-5pm. Clinic opportunities will depend on which inpatient service is selected. Team and ward rounds will be weekly.
On-Call Requirements:	Home Call. Typically 1/6 for inpatients on PMR floors only. No ER Call. Not responsible for Geriatrics or Complex Care units.
Description of Setting:	Parkwood Hospital - Resident space available both on unit and in separate area. This area will be with the PMR residents.
Supervision:	Family Medicine Hospitalist.
Clinical Content:	10-15 patients.

<p>Objectives/Expectations:</p>	<p>Responsibility: One inpatient unit (~10-15 patients) - either Stroke, MSK, Brain injury, Spinal cord rehab options.</p> <p>On call: as part of the resident rotation; home call only for Parkwood inpatients (not for ER); typically 1/6.</p> <p>Opportunities: inpatient daily rounds with hospitalist (management of diabetes, osteomyelitis, wounds, complex pain, autonomic dysreflexia, bowel and bladder neurogenic dysfunction, spasticity, injection opportunities, others).</p> <p>Round with physiatrist, typically 1-2x/week; outpatient physiatry opportunities to enhance learning needs.</p> <p>Team rounds weekly: to enhance learning of each discipline: OT, PT, SLP, Psychology, SW, Nursing.</p>
<p>Level of Residents Accepted:</p>	<p>R2 and R3. R1 who is at least 6 months into residency.</p>
<p>Teaching:</p>	<p>Lots of opportunities to teach medical students. Opportunity also to attend physiatry half days and teaching sessions (typically 2x/week).</p>
<p>Description of Location:</p>	<p>Parkwood Institute (St. Joseph's Hospital).</p>
