

Name of Rotation:	Pain Clinic - London
Description of Rotation:	Interventional Pain Clinic. Residents will do consults and learn about safe and effective multi-modal treatment of pain (self-management, injections, pharmacotherapy). Detailed approach to navigating opioids safely are included in the rotation. There will be opportunities to do injections within the scope of family medicine/ER medicine. CPSO does not allow residents to perform nerve blocks in this setting but trigger point injections, joint, bursa injections will be done. The mainstay is doing consults, to learn an initial approach to assessing and managing pain, and residents will be provided clear format in which to assess patients and guided along the way and reviewing each case.
