

<b>Name of Rotation:</b>	Sports Medicine – 3M UWO
<b>Description of Rotation:</b>	The Fowler Kennedy Sport Medicine Clinic provides Primary Care Sport Medicine care to the University's varsity athletes and serves the community at large. We see community patients of all ages and of all different levels of fitness and sports. The multidisciplinary sport medicine team consists of primary care sport medicine physicians, orthopaedic surgeons, physiotherapists, massage therapists, as well as custom bracing and radiology services.

<b>Description of Clinical Duties Performed:</b>	Residents will work with a variety of Sports Medicine Physicians throughout the rotation providing initial consultations, follow up assessments, and injections in the outpatient clinic environment. There are opportunities to spend time learning in the physiotherapy and/or bracing department.
<b>Sample Schedule:</b>	The resident is expected to participate as part of the medical team during clinic hours from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The resident is also expected to attend Primary Care Sport Medicine Rounds on Thursday mornings. Residents are encouraged to spend some time with other members of the Sport Medicine Team at the clinic. Depending on the time of year, opportunities to participate in sports coverage will be available.
<b>On-Call Requirements:</b>	Generally none with the exception of varsity preseason medical screenings (weekends), usually occurs in August/September.
<b>Description of Setting:</b>	Please see brief description

<b>Clinical Supervision:</b>	A sports medicine physician will provide clinical supervision. Will often rotate through a most clinicians on site throughout the rotation.
<b>Clinical Content:</b>	Acute and chronic sports injuries, arthritis, sports related concussion, female athlete health, guided and non-guided injections.
<b>Objectives/Expectations:</b>	Solidify MSK physical examination skills, exposure to a fast paced and multi-disciplinary environment, participate in injections/beside procedures.
<b>Level of Residents Accepted:</b>	PGY1,PGY2,PGY3
<b>Teaching:</b>	Attend interdisciplinary rounds, occasional opportunities to teach medical students.
