


ANOTHER WAY TO FIND DATABASES: BY TITLE LIST




MOST IMPORTANT DATABASE - MEDLINE

- PubMed Medline & Ovid Medline
- Same database, different interfaces
- Medline is published by the US National Library of Medline (NLM) & made freely available through PubMed
- US NLM leases the Medline data to commercial vendors like Ovid




USE REFWORKS TO KEEP TRACK OF ARTICLES



- CFPC librarian has dual role as CFPC librarian & Western Libraries librarian support for family medicine




