

## **Family Physician - Eastern Kings Health Centre - Souris, PEI**

**THE POSITION:** Full-time Permanent Family Physician-Eastern Kings Health Centre. This position shall replace a retiring physician who is 1 of 3 physicians working in the Souris area. The collaborative practice includes a team of physicians, a nurse practitioner, nursing and secretarial staff who work together to provide holistic care and positive patient outcomes. The physician will work from the Eastern Kings Health Centre co-located in the Souris Hospital. The physician will participate in providing primary health care services to a diverse population of approximately 6,000 people in eastern Prince Edward Island.
