

Schulich Graduate & Postdoctoral Awards

Jonathan & Joshua Memorial Graduate Travel Scholarship

Awarded annually to a full-time graduate student in a master or doctoral program at the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry specializing in mental health research, based on academic achievement and research merit. This scholarship will be used to support students attending scholarly conferences or meetings in order to present their research. Applications are available through the Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry Awards' application website. A committee within the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, with representation from a current member of the School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies, will select the recipient. This scholarship was established by Mr. Robert McKinnon (as well as many other family and friends) in memory of his sons Jonathan and Joshua.

Value: 1 at \$1,400 annually

Criteria:

Specialization of mental health research.

Eligibility:

Graduate students at the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry.

Deadline:

First Monday in May, each year
