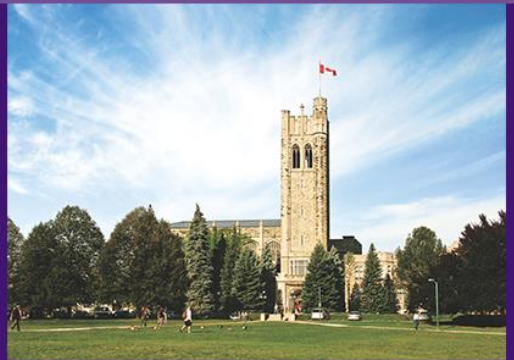

### Location

Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry at Western University in London, Canada. With a population of 350,000, London has many of the conveniences of a big city as well as the friendliness and appeal of a smaller center. London is a safe city that comes to life in the summer with many parks, festivals, and cultural events. It is situated a 2-hour drive from both Toronto and the USA border, making it an ideal location for students to explore nearby sights.

### Requirements

Qualified and motivated international undergraduate or graduate students who have completed at least 2 years of undergraduate study in a relevant degree program. At minimum, an intermediate English language comprehension.

### Dates

2-week program from July 16-27, 2018

Students should arrive in London by Sunday, July 15. Departure can be scheduled late day July 27 or July 28.

Expressions of Interest due March 31, 2018



## Theme



This year's theme is **Introduction to Global Health**. Students will look at global health from a multidisciplinary and multi-professional perspective. They will receive a high-level overview of global-health issues and priorities around the globe. Our aim will be to develop a new generation of clinicians and public health leaders, who will be able to tackle the complex and multidimensional issues that challenge population health globally.

## Cost

\$500 CAD – Tuition, on-campus activities and bus pass.

Students from a university that has an exchange agreement with the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry will be charged a discounted tuition fee of \$150 CAD.

\$550 CAD – Accommodation (This cost is an approximation based on the 2017 fees. The exact cost for the 2018 Program will be communicated to those accepted into the program.)

Other costs include airfare, medical insurance, Canadian student visa (if required) and are the responsibility of the student.

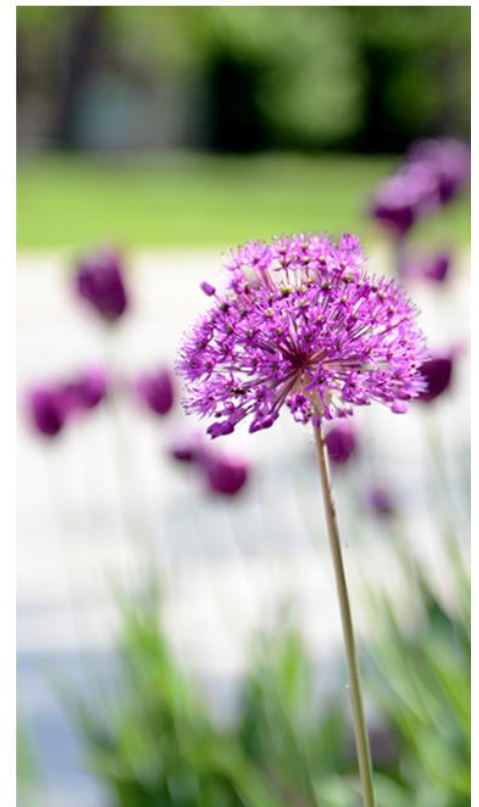

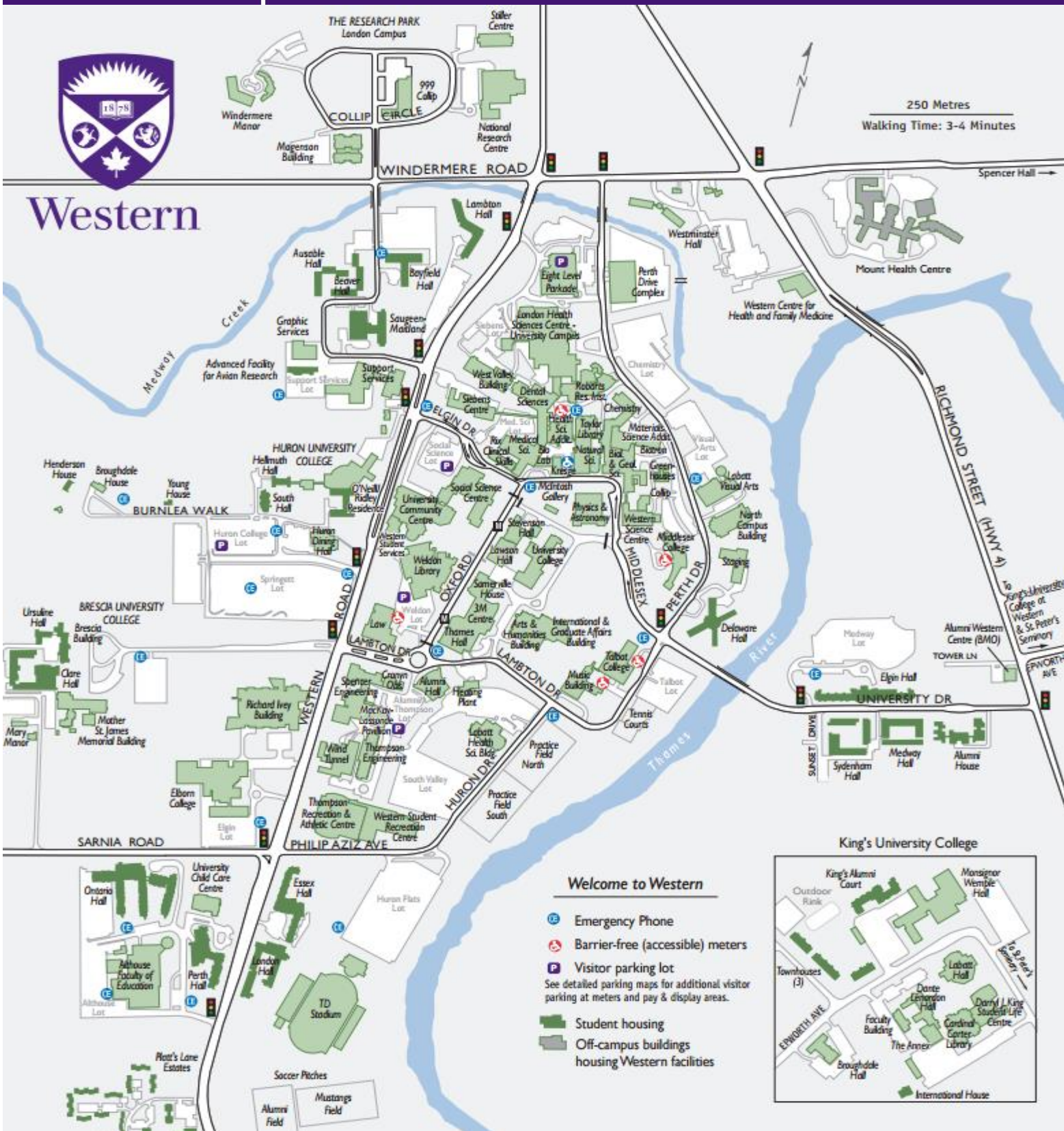




# Campus Map
