Uganda Demographics

- Landlocked country in East Africa
- 46.2 million inhabitants²
- Almost 1 in 5 citizens lives below the poverty line²
- Life expectancy 64 years, almost 10
 years lower than global average²
- Estimated 1.1 million people living with HIV/AIDS, upward trend in infection rates³

7-9% allotted of Uganda
National Budget allotted
for Healthcare¹

<0.1% for oral health services¹


National Oral Health Care policy: developed in 2007

 Limited focus on oral manifestations of patients with HIV/AIDS

Practicum Site #1: Joint Clinical Research Centre

- Established in 1991 to respond to HIV/AIDS epidemic
- · Collaborative research centre: CDC, NIH, John's Hopkins,
- Provides health care through multiple departments: Pediatrics, Cardiology, Radiology, Psychosocial, Pharmacy
- Dental care provided to medically complex patients














Our Research at JCRC

- Retrospective chart review investigating the relationship between HIV/AIDS and DMFT values in low SES populations
- Clinic experience with HIV patients while learning about oral health barriers









Practicum Site #2: Makerere Dental School

- New dental school opened in May 2022: 3 clinic buildings; 32 dental chairs; 30-50 students per year
- 5-year program (out of high school)













Makerere Dental Clinic

- Assisting and shadowing 4th and 5th year dental students with procedures
 - Pediatrics: Pulpotomy, pulpectomy, patient management with Dr.
 Samantha
 - Periodontics: perio data collection, cleaning and scaling
 - Operative and Endo: restorations and root canal treatments
 - Oral Surgery: extractions
 - o Prosthodontics: Crown cementation







Makerere Dental Clinic

- Positive learning environment
- Group sessions with clinical instructors: question and answer format











Practicum Site 3: Mulago National Referral Hospital

Teaching Hospital

- Government hospital
- Required 1-year internship
- Oral surgery residents

Referral Centre for publicly funded cases

- Visual of limited oral health care funding with long waitlists and advanced oral lesions
- Medically compromised, refugees, and low income patients







Practicum Site 3: Mulago National Referral Hospital



Outpatient Cases

Ameloblastoma, hemangioma, sub masseteric space infection, osteomyelitis, + fibroma



Inpatient Cases

Cancrum oris, unilateral TMJ ankylosis, trauma, mandibular fracture, + ossifying fibroma



Surgical Theatre

Internal fixation (mandible and zygomatic arch), + epidermal cyst enucleation









JCRC Clinic Chart Information:

 Date, age, gender, DOB, phone number, next of kin




 Presenting complaint, history of presenting complaint, past medical history, family social history, review of systems, oral exam findings, radiographic findings, diagnosis and treatment plan


Descriptive statistics of the JCRC patient population



Descriptive statistics regarding type of oral hygiene of JCRC patients and HIV status




HIV Status against DMFT values for JCRC patient population
