

YEARLY CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR CLINICAL PLACEMENT

SCHULICH DENTISTRY: GRADUATE ORTHODONTICS

The following requirements are informed by the Schulich Dentistry Immunization Policy.

All students must have completed their ERV appointment with Synergy Gateway Verified and obtained a status of PASS

For Year 1 students: by **Oct 1, 2026**

For Year 2 & 3 students: by **July 1, 2026**

Please note that documentation must be valid for the 2026-2027 school year. Documentation expiring before April 1, 2027 will not be considered valid. Therefore, please ensure to renew any documentation to comply with this date.

ENTERING REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STUDENTS TO GRADUATE ORTHODONTICS	
<p>These requirements are mandated for clinic-based learning and activity. Students are not permitted to begin any clinical experiences until proof of clearance is received for all below requirements. This checklist is for your tracking purposes only and is not part of the documentation required at your medical clearance appointment.</p>	COMPLETED & DOCUMENTATION UPLOADED
<p>Tuberculosis (Mantoux) – 2 Step TST (+ 1-Step TST if required)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Documented proof of a 2-step TB Skin Test (TST)• Documented proof of a current 1-Step TST if 2 Step TST was done more than 12 months ago. Must be conducted after April 1, 2026 to be valid until April 1, 2027.• If either TST is positive, the student will be required to seek medical follow-up and provide documentation of chest x-ray. <i>Chest x-ray documentation is valid for 5 years from the date of issue.</i>• <i>Documentation must remain current. If TST or X-ray is due to expire before April 1, 2027 it is advised to obtain new documentation. Otherwise learner will need to obtain new documentation and pay additional clearance fees</i>	
<p>Varicella</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A positive serologic test for the antibody, OR• Documented proof of 2 vaccinations.	
<p>Pertussis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Documented proof of vaccination. <p><i>Vaccination must have occurred after the age of 18 <u>AND within the past 10 years.</u></i></p>	

<p>Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A positive serologic test for antibody, OR • Documented proof of vaccination <p><i>NOTE: Two doses of measles and mumps vaccine and one dose of rubella are required</i></p>	
<p>Tetanus/Diphtheria</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of primary series of vaccines. • Proof of booster shot if primary series was completed more than 10 years ago. <p><i>Note: last booster must have been administered within the last 10 years.</i></p>	
<p>Polio</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are required to provide documentation of a complete series of polio vaccine. 	
<p>Hepatitis B –EACH OF THE BELOW REQUIRED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of primary series of Hepatitis B vaccines • Surface Antibody Level (Anti – HBs)- test for immunity* • Surface Antigen Serology (HBSAg)-test for infection <p><i>*if immunity is not shown an additional primary series & antibody test will be required. Students going through a second series can upload documentation of the first series, documentation of the first antibody/antigen serology and documentation of their second series that is in progress. Students can be allowed to conditionally pass an ERV appointment in their first year if a vaccination series is underway.</i></p>	
<p>Hepatitis C</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blood test required (titre) within the 6 months leading to the October 1 deadline. Documentation should include date of test and results (reactive/non- reactive). 	
<p>Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blood test required (titre) within the 6 months leading to the October 1 deadline. Documentation should include date of test and results (reactive/non-reactive). 	
<p>Influenza Annual vaccination recommended.</p> <p>Documentation of vaccination or attestation form must be uploaded to Synergy Gateway Verified by December 1.</p> <p>Note: SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINATION IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ANNUAL CLEARANCE APPOINTMENT (ERV)--students can upload this documentation at any time that immunizations are completed. Instructions for uploading documentation or attestation are posted on the Learner Experience Office website.</p>	
<p>COVID-19</p> <p>Annual vaccination recommended.</p> <p>Documentation of vaccination or attestation form must be uploaded to Synergy Gateway Verified by December 1.</p> <p>Note: SEASONAL COVID VACCINATION IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ANNUAL CLEARANCE APPOINTMENT (ERV)--students can upload this documentation at any time that immunizations are completed. Instructions for</p>	

<p>uploading documentation or attestation form are posted on the Learner Experience Office website.</p>	
<p>NON-MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS</p> <p><i>*Students with requirements expiring during the academic year must renew (before expiry) and provide updated documentation to the Synergy Verified Platform to continue to be eligible for clinical placement.</i></p>	
<p>Police Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screen To be eligible for clinical placements during the 2026–27 school year, students must submit a Police Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screen that meets the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The document must be valid for the 2026–27 school year and therefore must not expire before April 1, 2027. • A police check is considered expired one year after the date of issue. <p>⚠ Important: Obtaining a police record check with vulnerable sector screening can take more than 6 weeks, so please plan accordingly. Students must have a valid (issued within the past 12 months) police check to participate in clinical settings.</p> <p>Timing Your Request</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To ensure your documentation remains valid through April 1, 2027: • Do not request your police check too early. For example, a check issued on March 1, 2026 will expire on March 1, 2027, and will not meet the requirement. • To avoid this issue, request your police check so that the issue date is after April 1, 2026. • If you have any questions or need assistance, please contact the Learner Experience Office (learner.experience@schulich.uwo.ca). 	

Year 2 and 3 students:

Please note that all documentation meeting the Entering Student Requirements must be uploaded to your Verified account AND students must have received a notation of “PASS” on their previous year’s appointment with Synergy. To determine this, students must login to their account in Synergy Gateway’s Verified system and check what has been written for them under the Communications tab. If documentation is missing or follow up is required, you will see a notation. Please ensure you have all required documentation uploaded before your scheduled appointment to avoid extra charges.

The following checklists show what is required of students in each of Year 2 & 3 of all **graduate orthodontics** program.

If all required documentation has not been provided, a status of “FAIL” will be assigned to your file and you will not be permitted to engage in clinical activities until you have obtained the required documentation, have booked a follow up appointment, and paid the required fee.

RETURNING STUDENT REQUIREMENTS (Year 2 & 3 of Graduate Orthodontics Program) Deadline to pass Synergy ERV appointment: July 1, 2026 Documentation must be valid until: April 1, 2027	
MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS	COMPLETED & DOCUMENTATION UPLOADED
<p>Tuberculosis (Mantoux) – 1-Step TST</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documented proof of a current 1-Step TST if 2 Step TST was done more than 12 months ago. Must be conducted after April 1, 2026 to be valid until April 1,2027. • If either TST is positive, the student will be required to seek medical follow-up and provide documentation of chest x-ray. <i>Chest x-ray documentation is valid for 5 years from the date of issue.</i> <p><i>Documentation must remain current. If TST or X-ray is due to expire before April 1, 2027, it is advised to obtain new documentation. Otherwise learner will need to obtain new documentation and pay additional clearance fees</i></p> <p><i>*If a student has previously submitted an x-ray report to meet this requirement, x-ray documentation is valid for 5 years from the date of issue.</i></p>	
<p>Tetanus/Diphtheria</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of primary series of vaccines. • Proof of booster shot if primary series was completed more than 10 years ago. <p><i>Note: last booster must have been administered within the last 10 years.</i></p>	
<p>Influenza Annual vaccination recommended.</p> <p>Documentation of vaccination or attestation form must be uploaded to Synergy Gateway Verified by December 1.</p> <p>Note: SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINATION IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ANNUAL CLEARANCE APPOINTMENT (ERV)--students can upload this documentation at any time that immunizations are completed. Instructions for uploading documentation or attestation are posted on the Learner Experience Office website.</p>	
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<p><i>* Students with certifications/requirements expiring during the placement period must renew (before expiry) and upload updated documents to continue to be eligible for placement. This will require another appointment and there will be a charge for this appointment.</i></p>	

Failure to adhere to the requirement deadlines will result in a hold on your academic progress which could result in the loss of the academic term.
