

Police Vulnerable Sector Check for students in Graduate Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics

All students in Graduate Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics will interact with vulnerable populations throughout the course of their academic program. To ensure that students do not place vulnerable populations at risk, all students are required to provide, as a condition of their continued participation in the Graduate Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics program, a current Police Records Check including a Vulnerable Sector Screening (VSS).

Submission Deadline

For the 2026/27 academic year, this is due on **July 1, 2026**. Your VSS must be uploaded and reviewed as part of the Synergy Verified ERV process.

It can take several weeks for a police service to process an application, so begin as soon as possible to ensure compliance with our submission deadline.

Obtaining Your VSS through your local Police Service or OPP Detachment

[London Police Services](#) offers online applications for Police Checks including Vulnerable Sector Screening.

Schulich Graduate Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics will accept original electronic or scanned paper documentation issued by your local police service/OPP detachment if it bears an **electronic signature** or **embossed seal**.

While electronic documentation is preferred we ask that you do NOT enable restricted printing of electronic documentation.

Authorization Letter

If your police service/OPP detachment requires an authorization letter before you can apply for a VSC, email the following information to learner.experience@schulich.uwo.ca and an authorization letter will be prepared and emailed back to you. Please include:

- Your full legal name.
- The name of your police service. (I.e. OPP Kawartha Detachment; Vancouver Police Dept)

Obtaining your VSS through Toronto Police Service (TPS)

The Toronto Police Services-Police Reference check Program has moved to an online application system. <https://www.tps.to/police-checks>

To be eligible to apply for a VSC through TPS, the postal code of your primary residence must begin with "M" and you must be at least 18 years of age.

To submit your application:

You will require an Agency Code to submit your application.

Submit your Vulnerable Sector Screen (VSS) to Schulich Via Synergy Verified

You need to submit the original electronic or paper documentation to Synergy Verified as part of your Annual Clearance Requirements. During your ERV appointment, Synergy Verified will review your VSS and will contact you with the outcome 24-48 hours after your appointment.
