DUE DATE	MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS <i>These requirements are mandated for clinical activities. Students are not permitted to begin any clinical experiences until proof of clearance is received for all below requirements. Please refer to “Pre-Placement Clearance Appointment Instructions” and “MD Annual Clearance FAQs”. All documentation must remain valid until at least April 1, 2026. Any document that expires before this date will be considered invalid and will result in a failed Synergy ERV appointment. August 1, 2025	Tuberculosis (Mantoux) – 2 Step TST (+ 1-Step TST if required) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Documented proof of a 2-step TB Skin Test (TST) Documented proof of a current 1-Step TST if 2 Step TST was done more than 12 months ago If either TST is positive, the student will be required to seek medical follow-up and provide documentation of chest x-ray. <i>Chest x-ray documentation will be good for 5 years from the date of documentation</i> Documentation must remain current. If TST or X-ray is due to expire before the end of academic year note it is advised to obtain new documentation. Otherwise learner will need to obtain new documentation mid-year and pay additional clearance fees TB test or chest X-ray documentation must not expire before April 1 of the coming year. If your documentation will expire before this date, please ensure you get NEW testing and documentation. 	Varicella <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A positive serologic test for the antibody, OR Documented proof of 2 vaccinations. 		
	Pertussis <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Documented proof of vaccination. <i>Vaccination must have occurred after the age of 18 AND within the past 10 years.</i>		
	Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A positive serologic test for antibody, OR Documented proof of vaccination NOTE: <i>Two doses of measles and mumps vaccine and one dose of rubella are required</i>		
	Tetanus/Diphtheria <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Proof of primary series of vaccines. Proof of booster shot if primary series was completed more than 10 years ago. <i>Note: last booster must have been administered within the last 10 years.</i> 		

August 1, 2025	Polio <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are required to provide documentation of a complete series of polio vaccine. 		
	Hepatitis B –EACH OF THE BELOW REQUIRED: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Proof of primary series of Hepatitis B vaccines Surface Antibody Level (Anti – HBs)- test for immunity* Surface Antigen Serology (HBSAg)-test for infection <p><i>*if immunity is not shown an additional primary series & antibody test will be required.</i> <i>Students going through a second series can upload documentation of the first series, documentation of the first antibody/antigen serology and documentation of their second series that is in progress. Students can be allowed to conditionally pass an ERV appointment if a vaccination series is underway.</i></p>		
	Hepatitis C <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blood test required (titre) within 6 months of start of school year. Documentation should include date of test and results (reactive/non- reactive). Blood tests must be renewed at the start of Year 3 (prior to entering clerkship) 		
	Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blood test required (titre) within 6 months of start of school year. Documentation should include date of test and results (reactive/non-reactive). Blood tests must be renewed at the start of Year 3 (prior to entering clerkship) 		
December 1, 2025	COVID -19 Annual vaccination recommended. Documentation of vaccination or attestation form must be uploaded to Synergy Gateway Verified by December 1. Note: THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ANNUAL CLEARANCE APPOINTMENT (ERV) --students can upload this documentation at any time that immunizations are completed. Instructions for uploading documentation or attestation form are posted on the Learner Experience Office website. December 1, 2025	Influenza Annual vaccination recommended. Documentation of vaccination or attestation form must be uploaded to Synergy Gateway Verified by December 1. Note: THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ANNUAL CLEARANCE APPOINTMENT (ERV) --students can upload this documentation at any time that immunizations are completed. Instructions for uploading documentation or attestation form are posted on the Learner Experience Office website. August 1, 2025	Standard First Aid Must possess valid certification for duration of medical school. Students must upload documentation of certification. <i>Online Standard First Aid courses are permitted.</i> <i>Must be valid for the entire duration of each academic year.</i> Standard First Aid certification documentation presented at time of Synergy ERV appointment must be valid until at least until April 1 of the coming year or you will not pass the ERV appointment. If your certification will expire before this date, please ensure you renew your certification.	Your login details to book your Electronic Requirements Verification Appointment (ERV), through Synergy Verified will be sent to your email address once available.	
	CPR Level C (CPR-C) Students must upload documentation of certification. <i>Notes:</i> <i>1. Online CPR-C courses are permitted.</i> <i>2. CPR-HCP or BLS meet this requirement</i> <i>3. Students will be asked to renew this requirement every three years; must be valid for the entire duration of each academic year.</i> CPR Level C (CPR-C) certification documentation presented at time of Synergy ERV appointment must be valid until at least until April 1 of the coming year or you will not pass the ERV appointment. If your certification will expire before this date, please ensure you renew your certification.
