Failure to complete Post Admission Requirements and/or adhere to the deadlines specified may result in an offer of admission being withdrawn and/or removal from the MD Program.

Tuition Deposit *(required)*

A tuition deposit of CAD\$1,000 must be received by Western's Office of the Registrar by the deadline specified. Once your payment has been processed, your Student Center account will show -\$1,000. Your account will remain as a credit until your full tuition balance is updated, at which time your deposit will be applied against your tuition fees.

Subsequent withdrawal from the MD Program will be subject to a \$500 non-refundable cancellation fee.

Final Transcript *(if applicable, the following conditions will be stated in our offer letter)*

Undergraduate Degree

If our offer is conditional on the completion of 90 credits in your undergraduate degree:

- **By June 30:** Submit a final transcript to your OMSAS account via SAM, indicating completion of 90 credits towards your undergraduate degree. If you are unable to submit through OMSAS, your school must forward an official transcript via secure third-party transmission to Schulich Admissions at admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.

Course-based Graduate Degree

If our offer is conditional on the completion of your course-based graduate degree:

If your degree WILL be conferred by June 30:

- **By June 30**, submit a final transcript to your OMSAS account via SAM, indicating 'degree conferred'. If you are unable to submit through OMSAS, the transcript must be sent directly from your institution via secure third-party transmission to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.

If your degree will NOT be conferred by June 30:

- **By June 30**, submit a signed *Completion of Course-based Graduate Degree Requirements* form, which was attached to our offer letter, to your OMSAS account via SAM.
- **By August 22**, provide a letter from your Registrar's or Dean's Office indicating that all program requirements of your course-based Master's program have been completed. Submit the letter to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.
- **By November 30**, provide a final transcript indicating 'degree conferred'. The transcript must be sent directly from your institution to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.

Thesis-based Graduate Degree

If our offer is conditional on the completion of your thesis-based graduate degree:

If your degree WILL be conferred by June 30:

- **By June 30**, submit a final transcript to your OMSAS account via SAM, indicating 'degree conferred'. If you are unable to submit through OMSAS, the transcript must be sent directly from your institution via secure third-party transmission to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.

If your degree will NOT be conferred by June 30:

- **By June 30**, submit a signed *Completion of Thesis-based Graduate Degree Requirements* form, which was attached to our offer letter, to your OMSAS account via SAM.
- **By July 7**, provide a letter from your Registrar's or Dean's Office indicating that all program requirements of your thesis-based graduate program have been completed. Submit the letter to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.
- **By November 30**, provide a final transcript indicating 'degree conferred'. The transcript must be sent directly from your institution to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca.

Police Vulnerable Sector Check (required)

Incoming medical students are required to provide a current, original Police Records Check including a Vulnerable Sector Screening (VSC). For detailed information about the Police Record Check and VSC, refer to documentation on the Post Admission webpage.

- **By June 30**, submit a current, original VSC to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca

Only if a current, original VSC cannot be provided by June 30:

- **By June 30**, submit a *signed personal declaration* as a placeholder until your VSC is received.
- **By August 1**, submit a current, original VSC to admissions.medicine@schulich.uwo.ca

Western OneCard *(required)*

Western OneCard is more than just photo ID. It functions as identification for exams, bus pass, library card, meal plan card, and can be used for door access and vending machine purchases. It is also required to access Campus Recreation and to pick up a parking permit or keys.

University of Windsor Student Card *(if applicable)*

If you have been assigned to Windsor Campus, you will be issued a University of Windsor student card.

Your photo must meet the following requirements:

- Full face clearly visible and facing forward (no profile shots, sunglasses, hats).
- No graduation caps, gowns, or costumes can be worn.
- Nothing can be touching your face (no hands, flowers, graduation certificate).
- Must be colour with a uniform white background and no shadows; passport photo style is best.
- You must be the only person in the photo.

Tuition Fees – First Installment *(required)*
