DUE DATE	MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS	INSTRUCTIONS
August 14, 2024	<p>These requirements are mandated for clinic placements. Students are not permitted to begin any clinical experiences until proof of clearance is received for all below requirements. This list is for your tracking purposes only and is not part of the documentation required at your medical clearance appointment.</p> <p>Tuberculosis (Mantoux) – 2-Step TST (+ 1-Step TST if required) Documented proof of a 2-Step TB Skin Test (TST). If 2-Step TST was completed <i>more than 12 months ago</i>, a current 1-Step TST is also required. If either TST is positive, the student will require medical follow-up with chest x-ray.</p> <p>Varicella A positive serologic test for the antibody, or documented proof of 2 vaccinations.</p> <p>Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) A positive serologic test for antibody, or documented proof of vaccination (NOTE: For measles and mumps 2 doses of vaccine are required. For Rubella, documentation of one dose of Rubella vaccine is required).</p> <p>Pertussis Documented proof of vaccination. Vaccination must have occurred after the age of 18 and within the past 10 years.</p> <p>Tetanus/Diphtheria Proof of primary series of vaccines, If primary series was 10+ years ago, documentation of a booster within the past 10 years.</p> <p>Polio Students are required to provide documentation of a complete series of polio vaccine.</p> <p>Hepatitis B -each of the below is required: 1. Proof of primary series of Hepatitis B Vaccines 2. Surface Antibody Level (Anti- HBs) -test for immunity 3. Surface Antigen Serology (HBSAg)- test for infection <i>*if immunity is not shown an additional primary series & antibody test will be required. Students going through a second series can upload documentation of the first series, documentation of the first antibody/antigen serology and documentation of their second series that is in progress. Documentation should include date of the test and results of the test (reactive/non reactive). Blood tests must be renewed at the start of Year 3 (prior to entering patient clinics)</p> <p>HIV A blood test (titre) is required within 6 months to the start of the school year. Documentation should include date of the test and results of the test (reactive/non reactive). August 14, 2024	<p>COVID-19 Vaccination for Novel Coronavirus Disease. Full Vaccination (at least 2 doses) for COVID-19. A booster dose for COVID-19 is strongly recommended.</p>	
December 1, 2024	<p>INFLUENZA Annual vaccination. Note: THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ERV APPOINTMENT. Students can upload this document at any time that influenza vaccinations are completed.</p>	<p>Instructions for uploading this documentation are available on the Learner Experience Website. Reminders will be sent at the start of flu vaccination season.</p>

Fall 2024	<p>Basic Cardiac Life Support & First Aid Certification (CPR Level HCP) The Ontario Dental Association (ODA) will offer this certification free to all ODA student members through the school. THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT NEEDED FOR YOUR ERV APPOINTMENT. Refresher courses/recertification courses will be available to students through years 2-4. If you have already obtained CPR Level HCP on your own, please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Aid Certification is valid up to 3 years • CPR Certification is valid for 1 year only. <i>Please ensure your CPR Certification does not expire before September 2025</i> 	<p>This information is provided for your information.
