DUE DATE	MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS <i>These requirements are mandated for clinic placements. Students are not permitted to begin any clinical experiences until proof of clearance is received for all below requirements. Please refer to “Pre-Placement Clearance Appointment Instructions” and “MD Annual Clearance FAQs”.</i>	INSTRUCTIONS
August 14, 2023	<p>Tuberculosis (Mantoux) – 2 Step TST (+ 1-Step TST if required) Documented proof of a 2-step TB Skin Test (TST). If 2-Step TST was completed <i>more than</i> 12 months ago, a current 1-Step TST is also required. If either TST is positive, the student will require medical follow-up with chest x-ray.</p>	<p>To prepare for and book your Electronic Requirements Verification Appointment (ERV), please follow instructions on the document titled: <i>Pre Placement Requirement Clearance Appointment Instructions</i></p> <p>Your login details to book your Electronic Requirements Verification Appointment (ERV), through Synergy Verified will be sent to your email address once available.</p>
	<p>Varicella A positive serologic test for the antibody, or documented proof of 2 vaccinations.</p>	
	<p>Pertussis Documented proof of vaccination. Vaccination must have occurred after the age of 18 and within the past 10 years.</p>	
	<p>Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) A positive serologic test for antibody, or documented proof of vaccination (NOTE: Two doses of measles and mumps vaccine and one does of Rubella are required).</p>	
	<p>Tetanus/Diphtheria Proof of primary series of vaccines. If primary series was 10+ years ago, documentation of a booster within the last 10 years required.</p>	
	<p>Polio Students are required to provide documentation of a complete series of polio vaccine.</p>	
	<p>Hepatitis B –each of the below required: 1. Proof of primary series of Hepatitis B vaccines 2. Surface Antibody Level (Anti – HBs)- test for immunity 3. Surface Antigen Serology (HBSAg)-test for infection <i>*if immunity is not shown an additional primary series & antibody test will be required. Students going through a second series can upload documentation of the first series, documentation of the first antibody/antigen serology and documentation of their second series that is in progress. Students can be allowed to conditionally pass an ERV appointment if a vaccination series is underway.</i></p>	
	<p>Hepatitis C Blood test required (titre) within 6 months of start of school year. Documentation should include date of test and results (reactive/non- reactive). Blood tests must be renewed at the start of Year 3 (prior to entering clerkship)</p>	

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	<p>Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Blood test required (titre) within 6 months of start of school year. Documentation should include date of test and results (reactive/non-reactive). Blood tests must be renewed at the start of Year 3 (prior to entering clerkship)</p>	
Dec 1, 2023	<p>COVID -19 Vaccination for Novel Coronavirus Disease. Full Vaccination (at least 2 doses) for COVID-19. A booster dose for COVID-19 is strongly recommended.</p>	
Dec 1, 2023	<p>INFLUENZA Annual vaccination. Note: THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ERV APPOINTMENT. Students can upload this document at any time that influenza vaccinations are completed in the fall of 2023/</p>	Instructions for uploading this documentation are available on the Learner Experience Website. Reminders will be sent at the start of flu vaccination season.
DUE DATE	<p>NON-MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS <i>Students with certifications expiring during the academic year must renew (before expiry) and provide updated documentation to Synergy to continue to be eligible for clinical placement. This will require an additional appointment, for which there is a fee.</i></p>	
August 14, 2023	<p>Standard First Aid Must possess valid certification for duration of medical school.</p>	Online CPR/First Aid Training is permitted. Please ensure that the training meets the criteria for Standard First Aid and CPR level C.
