2.2 PGME Manager's Remarks – Scott Rumas		
Mr. Scott Rumas provided an update on the deadline for CaRMS, reminding the programs that the Internal Medicine Match Date is November 13, 2013. CaRMS R1 Match – Review of files date is November 20, 2013.		
Transfers – requests for transfers are now being submitted to the PGME Office and will be forwarded to the programs by October 18, 2013, with an expected response back to the PGME Office from programs by November 30, 2013.		
2.3 PARO Residents Report		
PARO recently closed applications for the PARO Leadership Program. This program was established 7 years ago in order to help build strong physician leaders. The three main objectives of this program are personal development, continuous organizational improvement and social contribution.		
While most spaces in the program are provided to PARO's elected representatives in order to provide training for their roles, a small expansion to the Program now allows them to offer a limited number of spots to general members.		
In addition to encouraging members to attend the Health Professionals Recruitment Tour, PARO hosted a booth at each of the six HPRT tour stops. PARO General Council Representatives at tour events ensured to reach out to residents present providing them with program specific listings of which booths were present at the tour, so that the information was individualized per resident.
