

Clerkship IPE Assignment

Shadowing an Allied Health Care Professional

Objective: The clerk will gain insight into the role, knowledge and skills of an allied health discipline while comparing insights with their own disciplinary role, knowledge, and skills.

Assignment:

- A. The clerk will be expected to do two assignments:
 - (i) Spend a half day shadowing a nurse;
 - (ii) Spend a half day shadowing one other health care professional. Select a health discipline listed on the Office of Interprofessional Education and Research web-site: www.ipe.uwo.ca under the 'Professionals in Teams' section.
- B. For each shadowing experience, complete a report based on consideration of the following questions:
 - 1. What specialized knowledge base and skills does the practitioner you observed possess? How does this knowledge and skill-base influence the way this practitioner provides patient care?
 - 2. Now that you know about the practitioner's unique skills and knowledge, would this knowledge influence your decision-making if this practitioner were to come to you with a concern about a patient? Please justify your answer, based on what you have learned from the shadowing experience.
 - 3. How can you, as a physician, work with this type of professional to enhance patient care and ensure patient safety?
 - 4. Can you see any potential for conflict between this professional, their practice and the patient-care team? How can you work effectively with such a professional in the future to prevent conflict regarding patient care?
 - 5. How would this practitioner's role be different in a different setting?
 - 6. Ask the professional what their one take-home message to the physicians of tomorrow might be, and reflect on what it means for you.
- C. Deadlines: First Essay: December 19, 2014 Second Essay: April 29, 2015

Practical Notes:

- 1. The clerk should consider choosing to do the observership with a health care professional who is actively participating in the care of a patient with whom the clerk is familiar.
- 2. The clerkship Rotation Directors are aware of this objective.
- 3. Clerks are responsible for completing the report outside of service hours.
- 4. The allied health care professionals may not be aware of this assignment. They may be given a copy of a letter explaining the assignment which is available on the Year 3 webpage.
- 5. The completed essays are to be submitted by email to Becky Bannerman, Clerkship Administrator.

6.	Each of the submitted essays will be assessed by a Clerkship & Electives Committee member who may provide feedback to the student. If the essay is does not meet expectations, the reviewer may request that the essay be redone.
