**I. PURPOSE**

Acknowledging that students learn through varied modalities, the Doctor of Medicine or Undergraduate Medical Education Program (Program) offers a recorded lecture management platform for students: The Kaltura Video on Demand (VOD) system.

**II. STATEMENT**

- 1.0 Schulich Video on Demand (VOD) will deliver recorded large group didactic sessions for London and Windsor students in Years 1, 2 and 4.
  - 1.1 The recorded lecture (lecturecast) is meant to serve as an adjunct to learning, offering students the opportunity to review lectures in a self-directed environment.
  - 1.2 Lecturecasts does not replace or supersede the benefits of attending class or experiencing lectures in a large group classroom setting.
- 2.0 Lecturecasts will be stored in an encrypted site owned and managed by the UME Program.
  - 2.1 Only students for whom the lecture was delivered will have access to the lecturecast.
  - 2.2 Lecturecasts will not be made available without consent of instructor
  - 2.3 Lecturecasts will only be made available for the current academic year and then will be deleted.
