

STATEMENT 3.2.15 - STATEMENT ON HOSPITAL IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

I. PURPOSE

Medical students enrolled in clinical learning experience in the Doctor of Medicine Program at the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry in Western University are required to wear any provided hospital photo ID badges as requested by the hospitals.

II. DEFINITIONS

III. STATEMENT

- 1. An authorized LHSC hospital photo ID badge request form will be included in the Clerkship or Clinical Sciences Electives orientation packages.
- 2. London clerks will take the authorized form to GO2HR Office at University Hospital to have their photo taken. This office is located in the basement Room CLL-102. At Victoria Hospital, students will go to C3-300.
- 3. Windsor students will continue to use the hospital ID badge that was provided to them at orientation in Year 1.
- 4. A Year 3 sticker will be provided to Windsor clerks during clerkship orientation week which should be placed on the ID badge under the student's name.
- 5. Students must wear their hospital photo ID badge at all times when in the hospital. It must be clearly visible.
- 6. Students must also wear their Western student photo card at all times.
- 7. Students learning in a Distributed Education, affiliated or Clinical Sciences Electives site, will be required to comply with the regulations for photo ID of that organization at all times.
