Ravi Bhargava, MD, DABR, FRCPC is a Professor of Radiology at the University of Alberta. He is the Chief of Radiology at the Stollery Children's Hospital. His primary practice is in pediatric radiology and adult neuroradiology. His grant funded research involves evaluation of new MR contrast agents in children, use of fetal MRI, using MRI to assess growth plates and its relationship to scoliosis, and assessment of islet cell transplantation. He has a strong interest in resident education and is the Program Director for the pediatric radiology resident training program, a Royal college examiner in Diagnostic Radiology, and the former chair of the Pediatric Radiology Specialty Committee at the Royal College.
