

LHSC is committed to complying with the Occupational Health and Safety Act by ensuring all staff and affiliates know how to respond to a critical workplace injury. To comply with a Ministry of Labour order, Occupational Health and Safety Services has developed critical injury training through ilearn.

All staff and affiliates are accountable to complete this one time training, which takes approximately 20 minutes. Please login to ilearn complete this training. If you have already completed this training, you will not be assigned or need to retake the training.
