

**DEPARTMENT OF ONCOLOGY – AWARD OF ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**

<b>THE AWARD</b>	Every year, the Award of Excellence honours the outstanding contributions of faculty in the Department of Oncology (DoO). This award provides the opportunity to recognize and encourage the ongoing development of outstanding talent in the department's five divisions (Medical, Radiation, Experimental, Surgical and Windsor Oncology). This award is based on evidence of excellence in a variety of endeavours with emphasis on peer recognition and exceptional performance. Only one award per division to be presented annually.
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	All faculty primarily appointed in Department of Oncology or a Cross appointment in good standing within the Department of Oncology may be nominated.

<b>CRITERIA TO BE MET FOR AWARD</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Administration:</b> Demonstrated leadership and ability in the area of departmental, university or hospital administration.</li> <li><b>Clinical Care:</b> Consistently demonstrated a high level of skill and achievement in the area of clinical care.</li> <li><b>Education/Teaching:</b> Consistent record of high achievement in medical education as demonstrated by high student ratings and leadership in educational development at the undergraduate, postgraduate and continuing medical education levels.</li> <li><b>Leadership:</b> Developed a reputation as a leader/leading expert amongst their peers, the London cancer community and depending on the candidate's seniority, the greater cancer community.</li> <li><b>Mentorship:</b> Demonstrated leadership role in medical education and who has excellent personal performance in teaching. The recipient will have developed a reputation as a role model and mentor to colleagues and trainees alike.</li> <li><b>Research:</b> Consistent scholarly output including research published in recognized peer journals, awarded industry recognized grants, and has been recognized by their peers and the larger cancer community as having made a significant contribution to their field of study.</li> </ul>
