Allergic rhinitis: Rupall is indicated for the symptomatic relief of nasal and non-nasal symptoms of seasonal allergic rhinitis and perennial allergic rhinitis in patients 2 years of age and older.¹

Dosage and Administration¹

ORAL TABLETS

For people
≥12 years of age

Recommended Dose
10 mg (1 tablet) once daily, with or without food

- The recommended daily dose should not be exceeded.
- Use in patients with renal and/or hepatic impairment is not recommended.
- Rupall should not be administered to children below 2 years of age.
- No dosage adjustments are recommended in subjects > 65 years of age.
