

MCISc Pathologists' Assistant (PA) Graduate Program AAPA Student Delegate Program Travel Award

The AAPA Student Delegate program invites two PA students from each PA program (USA & CA) to attend their <u>Annual AAPA Conference</u>, which happens in the <u>fall each year</u>. The benefits of being a student delegate is two students will be able to participate in a number of activities leading up to and including the conference. The AAPA will provide complimentary conference registration and hotel accommodations, with up to two students per room, for the length of the program. Student delegates will be responsible for their airfare, meals outside of those provided with their conference registration, and any incidentals.

Eligibility

MCISc Pathologists' Assistant Graduate Students in the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine must present a case report at our Annual Pathology and Laboratory Medicine Research Day to be eligible for this award.

Deadline

You must submit your case report by the Research Day abstract deadline. This deadline is typically in mid-February. Our Annual Pathology and Laboratory Medicine Research Day, is usually held in early Spring (mid to late March or early to mid-April).

Selection of Award

Your case report will be judged at our Annual Pathology and Laboratory Research Day. The judges' scores will determine the two Pas who will be selected as our student delegates.

Amount and Number of Awards

The department has made funds available for two of our students to attend the AAPA Student Delegate Program. The maximum award will be \$1,000.00 per year per student (maximum of 2 students). The MCISc Pathologists' Assistant Graduate Education Committee, however, reserves the right to change the amount or number of awards in any given year.
