### **Fellowship Requirements**

On-call commitments: Fellows will be required to take some call at the senior resident level

**Stipend**: Assistant fee for service through billings. All fellows are required to apply for any external funding for which they are eligible, including training grants and/or travelling fellowships from their home institutions/countries.

**Duration**: 1-2 years, depending on the goals of the applicant (July – June)

**Application deadline**: October 31 of the year prior to commencing the fellowship. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Successful applicant will be notified December 1 of the year prior to starting the fellowship.

## **Application requirements:**

- Completion of surgical training at a recognized surgical training program (either general surgery or plastic surgery)
- Eligibility for an independent license to practice medicine in the province of Ontario
- Updated curriculum vitae
- Three letters of reference sent directly to the program director
- Ministry of Health billing number
