The Residency Program Committee

The Residency Program Committee or RPC, helps the program director run the residency program in different portfolios and in discussions of broader issues.

RPC membership includes:

Residency Program Director – Is responsible for all aspects of the program. All other members of RPC report to the program director. The Program Director reports to the Schulich Associate Dean, Resident Affairs and the Department Chair.

Associate Program Director (London) – Oversees the curriculum (clinical and didactic), conducts quarterly review meetings with residents and assists the program director in various areas of the residency program

Associate Program Director (Windsor) – Oversees the Windsor training site, including the local clinical curriculum.

Assistant Program Director (Windsor) - Helps the Associate PD Windsor manage the Windsor site.

Competence by Design (CBD) lead – Is the chair of the Competence Committee and oversees the ongoing implementation of competency-based training. This includes the completion of EPAs by residents and supervisors and ensuring that residents complete their longitudinal training requirements.

Other members include: Psychotherapy Lead, Wellness and Safety Lead, Evaluations Lead, Scholarly Lead, Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Lead, Geriatric Psychiatry Lead, Transition to Practice (TTP) Lead, Interview Skills Lead, EDID Committee Representative, Resident COPE Representative, Resident Body President and Chief Resident.
