"Gender Confirming Surgery"



Visiting Professor Dr. William M. Kuzon, Jr, MD. PhD, FRCSC, FACS University of Michigan

Dr. Bill Kuzon is the Reed O. Dingman Professor of Surgery in the Division of Plastic Surgery at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. After undertaking his medical school education at the University of Rochester, he completed his Plastic Surgery training at the University of Toronto. During his time in Toronto, he also completed his PhD in skeletal muscle ischemia in the laboratory of Dr. Nancy McKee and two post-doctoral fellowships. Clinically, he then went on to do two Hand & Microsurgery fellowships at the University of Toronto and the University of Pittsburgh.

He has been an author in more than 120 peer-reviewed scientific papers and more than 400 conference proceedings. He has held grant funding from many organizations including the Medical Research Council of Canada, the National Institute of Health, and the Department of Veterans Affairs in the US. He has served as Chair of the Division of Plastic Surgery at the University of Michigan, as a Director on the American Board of Plastic Surgery, on the Board of Governors of the American College of Surgeons, as President of the American Society for Peripheral Nerve, and as President of the Plastic Surgery Educational Foundation amongst many other positions.

Dr. Kuzon has been Director of Surgical Services for the University of Michigan Comprehensive Gender Services Program since 1995. He has published multiple peer-reviewed papers on gender affirming surgery as well given many invited talks. In 2015, he was invited to be an advisor to the Secretary of Defense's Transgender Working Group at the Pentagon.
